
Dear Sir:

In reference to your letter requesting verification that you heard our station on the air at 1:00 A.M. on the morning of April 5 . We were on the air at that time conducting our regularly scheduled frequency test. As you stated in your letter we were playing Hillbilly music. Signed off air at 1:15.

Our regular schedule is the first Thursday morning of each month from 1:00 to 1:15 A.M. The only time we deviate from this schedule is when I am unable to make it due to sickness.

I might add that we have our CP for an increase in power from the present 250 Watts to 1 KW. and change in frequency from present 1220 to 1360. We are waiting for the arrival of our new Collins 20V transmitter.
