I am very pleased to report reception of WMOB by me in Englewood on the morning of February 1, 1971 during your equipment test. The following is what I logged on your signal:

- 1:34 A.M. CSQ rock music
- 1:36 identification, "This is WMOB in Mobile, Alabama conducting maintenance and equipment tests." Rock music continued.
- 1:39 identification as above. rock music.
- 1:41 1/2 identification, "So that we may better serve you, this is WMOB in Mobile, Alabama conducting maintenance and equipment tests". Nothing more was heard for a time but music was heard later on again.

Would appreciate it very much if you would send me a card or letter to verify my reception of WMOB. I have enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience in replying. Thank you very much for this favor.

Your signals were coming in here very well most of the time but had interference from WHAS in Louisville testing with open carrier and HJBI in Santa Marta, Colombia. Signal strength was Sp7 on the meter. My receiver is a Hammarlunds HQ-180 using a 125' long wire.

Will be looking forward to hearing from you soon. Good luck to you in your future broadcasting activities.
