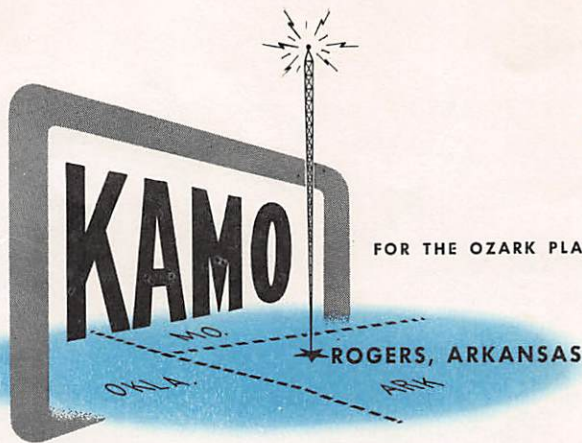

Thank you very much for the fine report on our new radio station. We are very pleased to hear from you and appreciate your comments.

This is the newest station in the area, and one of the very few that is remote controlled. Our studios are located above the American National Bank Building and the transmitter is about two miles west of Rogers.

We are using a 300 foot vertical radiator and a General Electric XT1A transmitter running (500 watts) half power. The remote control equipment is made by Gates and does a nice job.
