Your reported reception of KBL0 is correct in all details - I was most surprised to learn that we were being received so far north, considering all the other stations on 1470 KC.

We are a 1,000 watt - daytime station. We are using an antenna (vertical) of about $\frac{1}{4}$ wave, giving 185 mV/m at one mile.
