Thank you for your recent letter detailing your reception of KCCF, AM 1100 on January 31 and February 7, 1998. This letter confirms that reception and acknowledges the accuracy of your programming reports from 7:48 AM MST through 8:05 AM on Saturday, February 7, 1998 and from 5:08 PM MST to 5:22 PM on January 31.

KCCF is a brand new radio station licensed to Cave Creek/Phoenix, Arizona. We operate with 50,000 watts power daytime and 5,000 watts at night with a directional antenna which shoots most of our power to the southwest, south, and southeast.

We operate on 1100 khz 24 hours daily, 7 days a week. Our transmitter site is 32 miles due north of the center of downtown Phoenix and we transmit from a three-tower, quarter wave array 199 foot towers.

Our transmitters are both Nautel with phasor equipment by Kintronics. Most of our studio equipment is Denon and we use two Wheatstone control boards.

Our studios and offices are at 5227 North 7th Street in North Central Phoenix.

Again thank you for your recent signal report.
