Dear Mr. Nittler:

Thank you very much for your letter reporting reception of our signal. I apologize for the delay in answering, as it did not come to my attention until today. Apparently it was buried among other correspondence, and was forgotten.

The KZON transmitter is a Collins 300J 250-100 Watt AM Broadcast rig, and feeds a two tower directional array, which radiates our RF off into space, northeast and southwest. We operate 19 hours a day, with 250 watts and the same pattern at all times.

Thanks again for writing us. I enclose a coverage map, which shows our pattern. We hope you'll hear our signal again sometime. 'Til then, again thanks, and 73's - - -
