Dear Mr. Nitler:

Thank you for your reception report and I am pleased to verify your reception of CKVN's signal. The items and announcements you listed as having been broadcast were correct, and the frequency was also correct.

CKVN's legal power output is 50,000 watts, day and night, with a pattern change at night. The rig is an RCA BTA-50HI and the antenna is a three-tower array. Standby transmitting facilities include RCA 10-K/w and 1-K/w transmitters and a separate two-tower array. The studio-to-transmitter site program link uses both land lines and microwave STL systems.
