Indeed, it was KD-HI Radio that you picked up on the night of June 4th/5th. KD-HI was making it's monthly frequency check at it's scheduled hours of 12:30 to 12:45

According to our own log; the identification and tone was exactly as you described as receiving it.

KDHI is a brand new station located in the Southern mountain/desert area of California. The particular broadcast which you heard was our second official frequency check. Of iterest to you might be the fact that on our first frequency check one month previously; we were reported as being picked up in Walnut Creek, Pennsylvania - fifty miles west of New York City.

While you state that fading was a problem with your reception; this must have been somewhat general that night; for our own monitoring service just 125 miles away could not receive us steady enough to make the required frequency check.
