Your report of 9/14/70 from 3:07 A.M. to 3:09 A.M. was received, checked with the station log and found to be correct.


Radio KLOK is located approximately five miles southeast of downtown San Jose and operates with 50 kilowatts daytime and five kilowatts night, DA-2. Our antenna system is comprised of three 220-foot towers in line 71 degrees east of north.

An RCA BTA-50H Ampliphase transmitter is used during the day. The daytime pattern is such that protective nulls are created at 340 and 160 degrees.

At night, we use an RCA BTA-5/U transmitter and protect toward the east, mainly Oklahoma.
