Mr. Nittler:

This is to confirm your reception of Radio KNEZ during our frequency check from 12:00-12:15 AM the morning of December 29.

We transmit 500 watts on 960 kc with a Gates BC-500T transmitter into a 240 ft. series fed tower. The tower is 3 miles West of Lompoc. Our Studios are located in the center of town at 114 N. "H" St. in the Lompoc Theater Building. In order to obtain maximum modulation we use a Gates Sta-Level amplifier at the studio and a Gates Limiter at the transmitter.

You may be interested to know that at the same time you were receiving our signal, Mr. Francis H. Nittler of ~~Denver~~, Colorado ~~was~~ also receiving us, and we are sending him a confirmation today, also.
