KPOL-AM is 10,000 watts, 1540kc and KPOL-FM is 5,000 watts, 93.9meg. We broadcast 24-hours a day and the program to which you were listening was the "String Shift." We feel we play"the world's most beautiful music," nothing on the rock and roll side, and yet nothing classical.
