Bill:

Thank you for re-sending your reception report of Station KSPN/1110, dated 4/6/'01. I note that the address you sent the original report to was for the old KRLA, (the long-time call letters on the 1110 kHz frequency) which likely explains the lack of a response to your initial report.

Are you confused by the ESPN frequency hopping? (I am, and I work here...!) On 1/1/03, the calls KSPN moved to 710 kHz, and the station that was on 710 (KDIS) moved to 1110. Our signing a contract to carry the Anaheim Angles baseball games largely prompted the move; 710 has a better signal at night into Anaheim stadium!

Anyway, this will confirm your reception of KSPN, 1110 kHz on April 6, 2001 from 0623 – 0630 PDST. At the time of your reception, KSPN was operating from near Irwindale, California with 20 kW into a directional antenna system favoring the SW direction.
