Thank you very much for your reception report of our station on the morning of February 17, 1958.

This letter will serve as a verification of your reception, as you did send us a very complete report of our operation between 1:42 and 2;25 AM MST. (12:42 to 1:25 AM PST.)

The Susanville Junior Chamber of Commerce was holding a radio auction to raise funds for a portion of the community's share in the cost of a new County General Hospital. The Auction was on the air for a little over 13 hours, and raised \$6,016, from the donations sold and from cash donations.

Susanville is located in Northeastern California, on the eastern slope of the Sierra Nevadas, at a elevation of 4,195 Ft. We are operating with a composite transmitter, with a power of 250 Watts.
