Dear Mr. Nittler:

We were quite gratified to receive your letter reporting that you had received our signal in Englewood on New Year's morning.

At the time that you received us, we were on 1000 watts power, with a directional signal. Normally, we sign off at 11:15 P.M., but we remained on during the New Year's as a public service. During the daytime hours, KGHF can be heard as far north as Castle Rock, Colorado, but cannot be heard in the Denver area, due to KDEN which is on 1340 kilocycles.

It was a pleasure doing the all-night show on New Year's Eve. In the past I had a midnight til dawn show out of KVOB in Denver, until the station changed music policy and management. At that time, I was receiving letters as far south as Houston, Texas, and as far west as Los Angeles, California.
