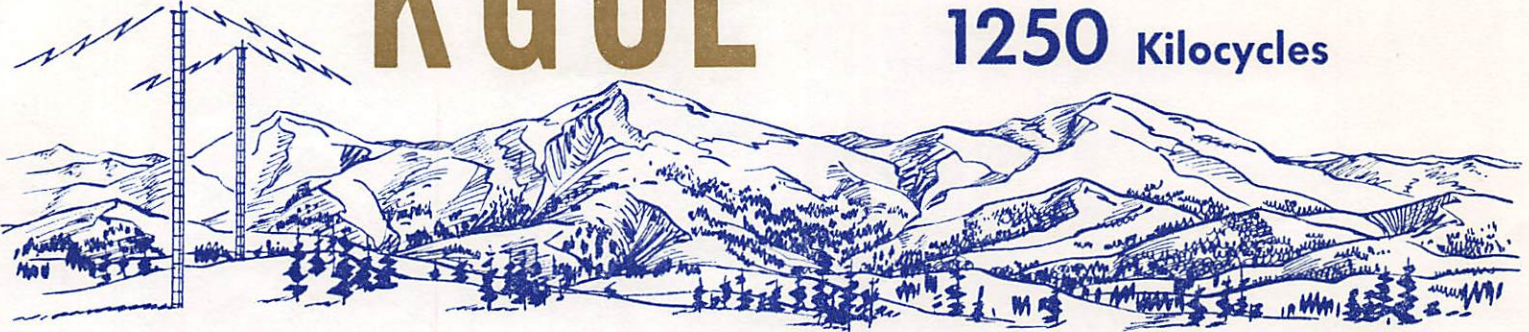

This will serve as confirmation of your reception of KGOL the morning of Oct. 21, 1957.

KGOL uses a Gates BC-1-J kilowatt transmitter with a two tower directional array. Our maximum signal area is toward the northwest. The studios are located in downtown Golden and the transmitter two miles southeast of Golden. Our frequency check broadcasts are scheduled for the third Monday of each month, 12:20-12:35 A.M.

If you will check back to your confirmation of KRTN, Raton, N.M. you will find I was Chief Engineer there at the time you logged KRTN. I moved to Golden in August of this year and took over here as Chief.
