Dear Bill:

Thankyou very much for your complete and acurate reception report, dated March 31, 1986. The program material you described indeed verifies that you heard our broadcast.

KGRE radio broadcasts on 1450 Khz with one kilowatt of power 24 hours per day. The KGRE transmitter is located just to the northwest of town. The transmitter is a Gates Radio BC-1T, made in about 1961. The KGRE antenna is 340' tall, making it about a 5/8s wave system.

Bill, you tuned in during one of the live segmants of our broadcast day. The only live programming is from 6:30-8:00AM, 12:00-1:00PM, and 5:00-6:00PM. The rest of the broadcst day KGRE is automated, with music and DJ chatter being delivered via satellite and local breaks and DJ liners inserted locally. It is quite a system and sounds quite "live" when done propperly.

Enclosed you will find one of our bumper stickers. If you ever get up this way be sure and look us up.
