This is to verify your report. KIDN is a pioneer in southeastern Colorado. KIDN went on the air in October of 1928 with the call letters of KGHF and for a long time was the only radio station in southeastern Colorado.

In the early 1950's, again we were pioneers in the broadcast industry by establishing KKFV Channel 11 and KFMN the first TV and FM stations in this part of the state.

In the early 1960's the call letters were changed from KGHF to KRAM. Now in 1976 we became KIDN, the most powerful and the only 24 hour a day AM radio station in southeastern Colorado with country sound.

KIDN operates with a power output of 5 Kw non-directional daytime operation and 1 Kw, 2 tower directional nighttime. RCA Transmitter BTA-5P. Studios and transmitter are located on Highway 50 West road to Canon City.

From our studios, you can see one of the most beautiful views of Pike's Peak and the Wetmore mountains.
