Dear Bill Nittler:

Thank you for your reception report of our station, KLRR in Leadville, Colorado. Our Program Director confirms that the advertisements you heard were, indeed, broadcast at the times you specified.

KLRR operates on 1230 kilohertz with a daytime output power of 1000 watts. At the time you heard us, we were operating at our daytime power level and changed to night time power of 250 watts at 5:45 pm. The transmitter is a Gates BClG with two 833As modulated by push-pull 833As. The antenna is a 194 foot shunt fed vertical at an elevation of 10,210 feet. This is the highest elevation of any commercial radio station in the fifty United States, AM or FM.
