Thank you for your report of reception of KMVP-AM Radio, dated March 3, 1987. From the information you provided, we were able to verify your report as being true and accurate.

Please accept this letter as your confirmation of reception of KMVP-AM radio on March 3, 1987, between 6:27 and 6:51 PM MST from your listening location in Mancos, Colorado.

KMVP-AM operates on 1600 KHz with 5,000 watts for both day and night operation. During daylight hours, KMVP-AM uses a non-directional antenna system consisting of a single 5/8 wave vertical radiator. During night hours, KMVP-AM uses a four-tower directional antenna system which beams our signal to the north from the Lakewood, Colorado area. Your reception of the station was during our directional operation.

Again, thank you for taking the time to write with your report. I'm sorry it took so long for us to respond to your report. I was away from the station for 11 months, and the acting technical director didn't keep up with our reception reports.
