Dear Bill:

Thank you very much for your report of reception of Radio Station KRXY-AM, dated September 26, 1984. I am sorry your original report wasn't answered. We do make an effort to answer every report that comes in. While looking through the files, I did not find your original report. However, I do remember your name. Anyway, we'll get it taken care of this time!

From the information you provided, we were able to verify your report as being accurate. I hope you will accept this letter as confirmation of your reception of KRXY-AM on September 26, 1984 between 7:50 and 8:25 PM, mountain time.

KRXY-AM operates 24 hours a day with 5000 watts of power. During night hours we use a four-tower directional antenna system, which beams our signal to the north from the Lakewood/Denver area. During day hours, we use a single 5/8 wave vertical, which produces an omni-directional signal pattern. You received our signals while we were using the directional antenna system.

Again, Bill, thank you for taking the time to write to us with your reception report. We always enjoy receiving the reports! And, I am sorry to say, our reception reports only go back about six years. The engineer before me didn't bother with QSL's, and didn't save any of the old reports. As a result, I don't have any of the reports your brother may have been involved with.
