I just took over this position since the broadcast was made and had to do a little research to find out Wa 'appined. So here's a conformation QSL. We did make a DX broadcast on 11 April, 1955 As indicted on the transmitter log.

Here's a little information that might be of interest to you:

Antenna.....205 foot vertical ground plane series fed with uniform web cross-section.

Ground.....120..200 foot #14 copper radials buried about 6 inches in salt-water sand.

Transmitter....BC-1F Gates 1 Kilowatt transhitter.

Associated Equipment.....Gates, Raytheon, General Radio, R C A, Presto, Doolittle, Electrovoice, and Magnecord.

We are quite proud that our signal is very good up to Brunswick and down South to Daytona Beach. Unfortunately our signal falls off rapidly inland but is very serviceable.
