We are currently contemplating going to 10kw, but who knows when this will come to pass - probably within the next five years or so. We are still 24 hours a day, but are off for maintenance between 3am-7:55am MST Mondays.

Am now doing the 5:30-9am stint here, which is somewhat of a challenge, since I used to roll into the studio about 8:58 for the 9:00 show. Sigh.

We hope never to experience 25° and if we do, I will probably move back to Miami. Right now it is about 83° and there isn't a cloud in the sky.

Thanks for your letter, and let us know if you hear us again, and if so, if any better. We have 13 stations on the island now, with 3 more CP's, one more applied for, and another on the way to being applied for, so you certainly have quite a variety to choose from. 73's.
