Thank you for your reception report for 1460 AM, on April 21, 1992. A check of the station logs would indicate that the programming you reported hearing at 10:47 PM, CDT on that date would be correct.

I am sorry your report was not confirmed before this time. As you can see our call letters and programing have changed since that time. But at the time you reported a reception of 1460 AM the call letters were KGGO.

Like KGGO was, KDMI is a 5,000 watt Regional AM station. We operate at 5,000 watts non-directional in the daytime and with 5,400 watts at night with a directional pattern. The extra watts at night are to make up for the loss of effecincy in the night load for the pattern.
