Your report of reception Of KFJB on January 8 1954 during frequency check with Commercial Monitoring Co. of Kansas City, Mo was correct. We operate that test the second Friday morning of every month at 1:15 Am to 1:30 Am CST.

Transmitter is an RCA BTA-250L with a carrier power of 250 watts, 1230 Kcs and six Am to Midnite hours of daily operation. Antenna is a 217' Lehigh self supporting vertical radiator with a ground system of 120 radials 240' long and 3 degrees apart buried 8 to 10 " deep.

Reports also came in that nite from New Cumberland, Penn. and Carey, Ohio. NRC members. Thanks very much for your report of reception.
