Thank you for your very fine reception report. We have delayed confirming your report because of a printing error on our QSL Cards. We were in hopes that this mistake could have been corrected before this time; however, in order not to delay confirmation any longer we have sent the enclosed card. The card should read 250 watts rather than 240 watts.

Our regular frequency test is scheduled with Commercial Monitoring of Kansas City, Missouri, on the first Tuesday of each month. It has been our practice to conduct this test some time after midnight which allows us time ('til sign on) to check and balance all the equipment. Since we are on a monthly frequency check basis we receive a telephone report on our frequency and operation of our G.R. Frequency monitor. We also have a G.R. modulation monitor.

Our transmitter is an old R.C.A. 250-G which uses a pair of 805's in the final and also a pair as modulators. The transmitter has an efficiency of 84 to 87 per cent of which we are mighty proud. Incidentally, this is not a grounded grid transmitter. The antenna is a one-fourth wave length (about 172 feet) shunt fed tower. We have a ground system of buried copper wires standard with Broadcast Stations. Two small creeks have been dammed to make a pond on two sides of the tower which gives us excellent ground conductivity around the tower. This exceptionally good counterpoise probably accounts for our unusually high efficiency. Our Console is a Raytheon RC - 11.
