
THIS WILL ACKNOWLEDGE, WITH THANKS, YOUR RECEPTION  
REPORT OF AUGUST 8TH.

WE HAVE A 1000 WATT TRANSMITTER LOCATED ABOUT 1½ MILES  
OUT OF TOWN AND RADIATE FROM A 200 FOOT STEEL TOWER. WE HAVE AN EMERGENCY  
STUDIO IN THE TRANSMITTER BUILDING AND ALSO A 5 KW GASOLINE GENERATOR TO BE  
USED IN CASE OF FAILURE OF LOCAL POWER SUPPLY. TWO 50' TELEPHONE POLES,  
SPACED 400' APART GIVE US AN EMERGENCY ANTENNA - A FLAT TOP - AND FINALLY,  
WE HAVE A SPARE 250 WATT TRANSMITTER TO BE USED IN THE EVENT OF OUTAGE ON  
THE MAIN SET. THUS, WE CAN CONTINUE BROADCASTING UNDER PRACTICALLY ALL  
EMERGENCY CONDITIONS.

WE HAVE MANY DX REPORTS SIMILAR TO YOURS, AND WE GET  
A FREQUENCY CHECK FROM KANSAS CITY ON THE FOURTH WEDNESDAY IN EVERY MONTH -  
APPARENTLY WE DO PUT A GOOD SIGNAL INTO MANY DISTANT POINTS.
