
Dear Bill:

Just a short note to verify your report of reception on our tone test on 13 November of this year. We're always glad to verify such reports and hear about the reception of our signal.

WKID is located at the east edge of Urbana and we are a daytime station with a power of 250 watts. All of our equipment is of Gates manufacture except for some of our tape machines. Our tower is a 300' triangular cross section guyed tower. The particular check you heard showed we were 2 cycles high from our assigned frequency of 1,580,000. We are allowed plus or minus 20 cycles.

It was nice hearing from you and we will add your letter to our collection of DX letters from practically every state in the union except the west coast. Usually we give a code word which we require the listener to furnish before we will verify. However, on this particular date no code word was given.
