Thank you for your letter reporting reception of WISH on August 11. In checking the program log, I find that your report was entirely accurate.

That is a nice piece of DXing on your part inasmuch as we are using 5 kw. on 1310 kc. which isn't too conducive to long-distance reception.

In daytime, we transmit an omnidirectional pattern from a single tower with 5 kw. At night, we use a three-tower directional array with 1 kw. Our transmitter is an RCA BTA-5H, brand-spankin new.

Again, many thanks for your report and we hope you'll be able to pick us up again.
