This is to verify your reception of WPCO Mt. Vernon, Indiana, U. S. A.; during our test broadcast on February 26, 1963. WPCO has received correspondence from all over the world as well as every area of the U. S. A. WPCO uses Gates equipment from turntables to transmitter. Our transmitter is a Gates BC 500 GY and is about seven years old. The antenna is a wind Charger 188' overall height uniform cross section shunt excited steel radiator and the ground system consists of 120 buried copper wire radials 165' in length. WPCO is a daytime station only.
