Dear Mr. Nittler:

We deeply appreciate confirmation of our signal report on Thursday, April 3, 1963.

We are operating on an assigned frequency of 1560 kc and a power of 250 w.

We are extremely fortunate to have ground conductivity of 30% at our transmitter site which should allow us ordinary primary coverage of six counties in this area.

Of course, the heaviside layer and the time of the morning has given us skips into your area as well as others: eg Connecticut, Canada, etc.

Our equipment is 100% Collins. The studios proper are located approximately two miles from the transmitter site and control is maintained through the use of a Sheaffer remote. Collins cartridge units and Ampex tape recorders are used. Microphones are Collins and RCA 77.

If at any time you happen to be in our area, we extend an invitation for you to visit us.
