WINN operates on 1240 KC with a power of 250 watts and is the only full time independent station in Louisville. We are on the air 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Our studios are located on the fourth floor of the Speed Building at Fourth and Guthrie Streets. Our transmitter is located at the end of Saunders Avenue. The main transmitter is a Collins 300J-2 with a General Electric limiting amplifier and the alternate main transmitter is a Collins 300FA with a Collins limiting amplifier. The antenne is a guyed 200 foot stainless steel tower with 120 200 foot radials.
