We are very pleased to cerify your reception report of our Le Pas station, C J A R on 1240 Khz. (1000 watts day; 500 watts nightime)

We are extremely lucky to be able to obtain a fine ground-system in this 'very 'rocky' Province of Manitoba.

This contributes greatly to our effective output pattern.

The population of Flin Flon (CFAR; 10,000 Day; 1000 nightime) is approximately 10,000 with the major industry being provided by a huge Copper-Zinc-Nickel mine situated on the outskirts...The smoke-stack is 825 feet high!

Being an active Amateur Radio Operator(HAM) I'm pleased that we were able to install our 2 metre(144 to 148 mhz) transceiver and antenna at the 725 foot level... This gives us in excess of 100 miles solid mobile radio communication... In addition, I've got a 50 foot tower for my 20 metre beam....

You mentioned that you quite often travel around Canada;;;;;Possibly you would like to visit Flin Flon during the annual trout festival or Le Pas during the annual Dog-Derby-Races...
