This is to verify your reception report of W K N K of October 3rd, 1954. W K N K is a class III A Station operating on a regional channel of 1600 KC with a fulltime power of 5000 watts. Da night only.

Our equipment is Gates all the way. Our X- mitter is Gates model BC5B. We are located approximately segen miles east of Lake Michiganand five miles S.E. of Downtown Muskegon. Our antenna system consists of in-line towers of uniform height, apporoximately 150 feet above the ground insulators using series feed. We use the center tower only for non Da operation, Daytime operation and feed all four towers for night operation.
