Radio station KANO is a daytime station with a pre-sunrise authorization operating at a frequency of 1470 kilohertz with a power of 1000 watts during the day and 500 watts before sunrise. The transmitter is a Collins 20V-2 feeding a 400 foot tower which is shared with sister station KTWN-FM. The studios and transmitter of KANO are located one mile north of Anoka on state highway 47 about 25 miles north-northwest of Minneapolis. KANO programs middle of the road music from 6:00 A.M. to sunset seven days a week.
