There is a possiblity that we might stage a 1/2 hour monthly test program on a regular basis. in the event this becomes effect. we will notify you by mail that you might listen and report to once again.

KTIS uses a 300 foot guyed vertical antenna and our Western Electric transmitters are operated by remote control from our studies on the second floor of Northwestern College in downtown Minneapolis. Our transmitter estate is located at Golden Valley, Minnesota about 8 miles Northwest of Minneapolis.
