This is to confirm your reception of a special test conducted Monday April 18, 1977, from 0200 to 0238 CST, in conjunction with the Golden West DXers Association and other DX clubs. KVOX was running 1000 watts non-directional programming tones, ID's and jingles.

KVOX is the number one rated contemporary station in the Fargo-Moorhead market and operates with a daytime power of 1000 watts non-directional and a night time power of 500 watts with a directional antenna on 1280 kHz. We presently have an application in for 5000 watts day and 1000 watts night. KVOX has an operating schedule of 24 hours-a-day and has been on the air since 1937.
