Dear Bill,

I'm just a bit late with this, but this letter will confirm your reception of KTTS-AM on the morning of May 8, 1972. The log of programming for that period is essentially correct.

It is always a pleasure to know that we are being heard out-side the immediate Springfield area. As you are aware, we operate with 1,000 watts daytime and 250 watts at night on 1400 khz. We use an RCA BTR-1R transmitter and operate 24 hours a day on AM. Our FM station operates at 94.7 mhz with 10KW Erp using a collins 830 transmitter. We duplicate Am and FM about 50% of the time.

In case you ever log either of our stations again we will

be happy to hear about it.

While KTTS is an old-timer, the station is completely new in sound since mid March. We switched from a dead old CBS CMOR format to upbeat country at that time. We are owned by the same comportation as KFDI in Witchita, Kans., a station you may have logged.

Thanks again for your report.
