We were glad to hear from you stating your reception of KANA on the morning of March 7, 1955. You were correct about Teresa Brewer's "I Gotta Go Get My Baby." selection being played first on our monthly frequency check, which is the first Monday of every month at 3:15 till 3:30 MST, and our Frequency of 1230 kilocycles and power of 250 watts. As for the other selections played I don't recall the titles.

Radio Station KANA is located just east of Anaconda, Montana on Highway 10A. Anaconda's population is about 12,000. It is the location of the world's largest stack, the smelter is owned by the Anaconda Copper Mining Co.. The Copper smelted is brought to Anaconda from Butte, Montana where it is mined and known as the "Richest hill on earth."

Anaconda is located 80 miles southwest of Helena, Montana, the capital, and 25 miles west of Butte, and Southeast of Missoula, Mont. Montana is known as the "Treasure State".
