Dear Mr. Nittler:

This will verify your reception of radio station KBMY on the morning of January 5, 1954, between the hours of 1:30 AM and 1:45 AM, MST.

For your information, KBMY has a regular test program on the air on the first Tuesday of each month between 1:30 AM and 1:45 AM, MST. Identification can be made by a 850 cps tone with station ident. at five minute intervals.

Equipment here consists of Gates transmitting equipment (250 watts) using push-pull 810's in the final RF amplifier modulated by push-pull 810's class B. Our antenna is of uniform cross section, guyed, and 406 feet high, close to an electrical ½ wave at 1240 kc.

Many thanks Mr. Nittler for your reception report. We hope to hear from you again in the future.
