Dear Mr. Nittler,

In answer to your letter of April 17, 1957, this is to verify your reception of KFBB Radio on December 10, 1956, at which time we were conducting a broadcast for purpose of frequency measurement.

For some reason your original request for verification, which you mentioned, never reached my desk. I always try to send out verifications by return mail.

KFBB Radio uses a Western Electric 355-D-1 5KW transmitter. We operate with non-directional antenna during daytime and with directional antenna at night. The frequency check broadcast is made, however, with non-directional antenna.

Enclosed is our current program schedule for both radio and television. Should you ever make a trip up this way ...we're right on the route to scenic Glacier Park... stop in and let us show you around. The KFBB Radio and Television Center is located two miles West of the Electric City on the Al-Can highway.

I want to thank you for your reception report, and am sorry that I didn't receive your original request.
