Thank you so much for your letter of October 13, 1969.

Yours was one of many letters we've recieved since the owners of KKGF purchased the old KFBB Radio of Great Falls, Montana. Since our take over we've come up with a considerably better signal than in the past. KFBB was still operating with an old WESTERN ELECTRIC TRANSMITTER circa 1936 with an authorized power of 5kw - but the old water cooled baby was only putting out something in the neighborhood of 3750 watts. The old girl was retired in favor of a ten year old RCA 5kw rig in pretty good shape.

Thanks to you and club members like yourself we have a good indication that our signal is getting out like it should.

Weather here has been on the cool side, too ... 10 to 20 degrees below normal for this time of year. The mountains are snow covered ... some slippery spots through the high elevation passes ... but not much snow in the lowlands. But there's no doubt that winter is on its way here too ... though not to the extent that is appears in Englewood.
