A few days ago we received your report of reception of our Station which broadcasts on 690 kilocycles.-
It pleases us to inform you that, verily, on the day you mention, at 4:57 a.m. EST, we were broadcasting Cuban music played by our outstanding orchestras featuring our most popular singers.-

At 5:00 a.m. EST the following announcement identified our Station:

"Radio Progreso, Cadena Nacional, la Onda de la Alegría,- Transmitiendo desde la Habana, Cuba, Territorio Libre de América"

(This is Radio Progreso, National Network, The Wave of Joy, Broadcasting from Havana, Cuba... Free Territory of America)

At 5:05 a.m. EST our announcer introduced a Cuban musical number sung by Wilfredo Mendi. And at 5:10 a.m. EST our announcer again identified the program announcing it in Spanish.-

As you can see, our answer verifies your report. Your listing of the call letters of our Station as CMBC is correct.

We are pleased to give you some information concerning Cuban broadcasts:

We sincerely recommend your monitoring a new program that is being broadcast daily from 12:00 midnight to 5:30 a.m. entitled "The Voice of Cuba", from which you can obtain abundant information about our country, besides listening to the best renditions of our national music.
