Dear Mr. Nittler:

Many thanks for your letter reporting reception of XEO on January 3 in Geneva, Nebraska.

The XEO transmitter plant is located about 2 miles west of Matamoros on the Reynosa highway. As you may know, Matamoros is directly across the Rio Grande from Brownsville, Texas. Our antenna is a self-supported 250' Blaw Knox tower tuned to a quarter wave. Our transmitter is a composite, built by our own engineer.

XEO's regular broadcast schedule is from 5 AM to 12 midnight Mondays through Saturdays and 6 AM to 10 PM Sundays. All out broadcasting is in Spanish except for the English language station identification which you reported.

Thanks again. We're always glad to have reports from DXers.
