Dear Gentleman: -

I have on hand your nice report of the morning of the 19th. We were on the air that night, testing our 1000 Watt transmitter after having done a few minor repairs, - as we are only on the air daily 'til 9:00 O'clock P. M .----

Our Transmitter is of Gates Make and we have besides an RCA 250 Watt Auxiliary one, which also works daily after sun-down, -to closing hours, which is 9:00 O'clock and began at 7: A.M.

. We are located at a latitud of 30-21-55 degrees north and 107-58-42"degrees west Longitud .- We use a 76.5 Mts. vertical antena made of water pipe line beguining at the bottom with a 6 inch pipe and ending with a 2 inch, with a heavy and special porcelain base tested for a 10,000 Watt spark-jump. -

Casas Grandes is a small town of about 20,000 population and is our Galeana's county xite seat .- We have a great lumber industry and hevay cattle grazing with a considerable farming .- We raise Wheat, alfalfa, Corn, Beans and cotton. - There are three great flour mills in town and we have a large meat-packing plant which exports meat to U. S. and Europe .-

There is a small town north of Here which is called DUBLAN cattle grazing, -and mikk by-products, such as Cheese, butter and etc. -

Our Station is located in-between Casas and Dublan, these two towns are about one mile apart and we there-fore are 1/2 mile from the transmitters in same building and our antena is near-by. We own our property and building. We have been on the air since 1949.

Hoping that I have made things little clearer off our city, Radio-Station an etc. I beg to remain. - Yours very truly-
