Dear DX Listener:

Thank you for your reception report of "YNOL Waves of Light" on December 4, 1962 and January 1, 1963. This letter is a verification of your report.

YNOL operates on 828 kc. with a power of 15,000 watts using three 3X 2500 F3 tubes in the final. We have the most powerful transmitter in all Central America and it was constructed here at WNOL. The antenna is a 305 ft. vertical radiator. The transmitter-studio building is located about eight miles southwest of Managua, the Capital of Nicaragua. In addition, we have a downtown studio.

We have been on the air since March 8, 1959, and are broadcasting daily from 6:00 a.m to 9:00 p.m (C.S.T.) in the Spanish language, and from 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 P.m (C.S.T.) in the English language.

We will appreciate if you can have a copy of the tape with our signal and mail it to us.

We trust our programs have been an inspiration to you.
