This letter is to confirm your reception of 1620 KAZP. KAZP is the latest addition to the Mitchell Radio Group family. She joins sister stations KKAR, KQKQ, KZFX and KOIL in Omaha; KHUB and KFMT in Fremont; KQKY, KRNY and KGFW in Kearney; and KXNP and KODY in North Platte, NE.


KAZP's signal is being diplexed onto the center tower of the KKAR directional array. We are currently using temporary antenna tuning units while we await a new phaser for the KKAR directional array. The new phaser and antenna tuning units should be arriving shortly from Phastek in Pennsylvania.

We appreciate your reception report from Colorado. At one time, I was an avid broadcast and shortwave DXer. Unfortunately, I don't have as much time to DX as I once had. I feel lucky to be able to fire up the old Yaesu FTdx-100 and shoot a little 40 metre CW from time to time.

Thanks for listening. Keep an ear out for our other stations across Nebraska. You might be able to catch 1240 KODY from your location in Colorado.
