Thank you very much for your letter. We are very happy to add your letter to our growing wall of letters from reports over the country. I have been saving all the letters since we started.

To tell you a little bit about our station... We started here in Ainsworth February 6, 1968, so we still haven't really got our feet wet yet! We operate on an unlimited time license, 1000 watts day, 250 watts nite. We close shop at 10 Pm. Our time is now Central time so the frequency check on Mountain time seems quite late.

Hope you have the opportunity to pick up the other Nebraska station's soon. I have a friend from Missouri who was managing the station in Nebraska City but has since left there. He had problems finding enough 1st class men for his directional operation.

You listed the stations in Nebraska that you have not picked up so expect you have caught the one in Wayne, Nebraska. They went on the air at about the same time we did.

Don't remember exactly what kind of weather we had Friday nite, but must have been cloudy as we have had several days of cloudy, rainy and snowy type weather here.

Again, thank you for the letter. Still haven't received our report back on the check yet from Vir James Associates out in your country.
