KBRK AM & KBRK FM Brookings, South Dakota Your report of reception of Radio Station KMEM October 20, 1993 has been compared to station program logs for that day and found to be in substantial agreement. KMEM is now operating with a power of 2.5 kW day using a five element directional antenna. Nightime operation is currently at 0.5 kW using a four element directional antenna. During daytime operation, the major lobe of radiation extends to the southwest. The signal can be heard a good distance at certain times, as you have discovered.
