I have been especially curious lately as our monitoring station is in Austin, Texas, on Central Time and we have been having quite a hassle recently over whether I was supposed to broadcast the test at \$4:45 Central time or 4:45 Daylight Time.

I have only been chief here a few months and yours is the first DX letter I've received. I may become a sort of dxer myself and see how far away I can put out a signal.
