I apologize for not returning your original request for verification; I never saw it.


As you may know, KCQL operates fulltime with 1kw. KCQL broadcasts in C-Quam AM stereo 24 hours a day.

Our transmitter and tower are located in Aztec.

I'd like to thank you for your comments on our programming! Between our two stations, KCQL is my favorite..and living in Durango it frustrates me that I cannot hear our signal at night; although it is sometimes possible to pick it out of all the signals on 1340. By late afternoon, I notice interference from co-channel stations in Taos, New Mexico and Salida, Colorado.
